



**Section I: Purpose**

The purpose of this Local Law is to supersede Town Law §24 by changing the Term of Office of the Town Supervisor from two (2) years to four (4) years.

**Section II: Statutory Authority**

Pursuant to Municipal Home Rule Law §10 (1)(ii)(a)(1) and §10(1)(ii)(d)(3) the Town of Geddes is permitted to adopt a local law relating to the mode of selection, term of office, and residency requirements applicable to its officers and employees.

**Section III: Change in Term of Office of the Town Supervisor from Two (2) to Four (4) years**

Upon the effective date of this Local Law, the Term of Office of Town Supervisor within the Town of Geddes is hereby changed from two (2) to four (4) years. The change in the Town Supervisor’s Term of Office will apply to the Supervisor elected at the next biennial election for the Office of Town of Geddes Town Supervisor, and to all Town Supervisors elected thereafter.

**Section IV: Supersession**

Pursuant to Municipal Home Rule Law §10 (1)(ii)(a)(1) and §10(1)(ii)(d)(3) this Local Law shall supersede Town Law §24 with respect to the Term of Office of the Town of Geddes Town Supervisor, by changing the said Term of Office from two (2) to four (4) years.

**Section V: Mandatory Referendum**

Pursuant to Municipal Home Rule Law §23 (2)(E), this Local Law is subject to a mandatory referendum and shall therefore be submitted for approval to the electors of the Town of Geddes at the general election held in November 2018.

**Section VII: Effective Date**

This Local Law shall become effective upon filing with the Secretary of State after approval by a majority of the electors voting thereon in accordance with the provisions of §27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

**A LOCAL LAW SUPERSEDING TOWN LAW §24 BY CHANGING THE TERM OF OFFICE OF THE TOWN OF GEDDES HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDANT FROM TWO (2) YEARS TO FOUR (4) YEARS IN THE TOWN OF GEDDES**

**Be It Enacted** by the Town Board of the Town Of Geddes as Follows:

**Section I: Purpose**

The purpose of this Local Law is to supersede Town Law §24 by changing the Term of Office of the Town of Geddes Highway Superintendent from two (2) years to four (4) years.

**Section II: Statutory Authority**

Pursuant to Municipal Home Rule Law §10 (1)(ii)(a)(1) and §10(1)(ii)(d)(3) the Town of Geddes is permitted to adopt a local law relating to the mode of selection, term of office, and residency requirements applicable to its officers and employees.

**Section III: Change in Term of Office of the Town of Geddes Highway Superintendent from Two (2) to Four (4) years**

Upon the effective date of this Local Law, the Term of Office of the Town of Geddes Highway Superintendant is hereby changed from two (2) to four (4) years. The change in the Town of Geddes Highway Superintendant's Term of Office will apply to the Highway Superintendent elected at the next biennial election for the Office of Town of Geddes Highway Superintendent, and to all Highway Superintendants elected thereafter.

**Section IV: Supersession**

Pursuant to Municipal Home Rule Law §10 (1)(ii)(a)(1) and §10(1)(ii)(d)(3) this Local Law shall supersede Town Law §24 with respect to the Term of Office of the Town of Geddes Highway Superintendent, by changing the said Term of Office from two (2) to four (4) years.

**Section V: Mandatory Referendum**

**Be It Enacted** by the Town Board of the Town Of Geddes as Follows:
