Minutes:

Meeting called to order at 5:02 pm. Present was Councilor Krawczyk , Councilor Lafex, and The Town Engineer William Morse. The Town Highway Superintendent Paul Trovato was excused.

Discussion on the Year 2018 overall was positive for the Highway Department except some things, which the town has to focus in the Year 2019

- 1- Paving – the way we are going right now as far as revenue from CHIPS Program and other grants it would take 50 years to pave all of the roads in the Town of Geddes.
The CHIPS Program has not been raise raise for years because the money comes from gasoline tax in the state.
- 2- The Highway Committee is going to ask the Town Board for permission to approach the County of Onondaga to maintain Fay Road. The cost of Fay Road is to expensive for the township and the Village of Solvay to maintain. Fay Road is a high volume of traffic about 8000 vehicles per day.
- 3- Blueberry Lane – There is a section that is need of new piping because it has broken due to age. To fix this pipe it will cost about \$150,000.00. The town will approach the state and the county for help or grants.
- 4- Beach Road Project – Ditch project for drainage problems will cost between \$60-\$75,000 – The town will approach the state and county for help or grants — this project has to be done for building the new school bus garage.

Meeting ended at 6:02p.m.
