- 1- Discussion with the Village of Solvay of sharing highway services and equipment.
  - A- To continue snow plowing agreement
  - B- Transfer Station
  - C- To buy a trailer to share for heavy equipment and equipment operator will be supplied by the Village of Solvay- will get exact figures of cost next meeting
- 2- Town street repairs are in the process Granger Road , Stoney Drive and various other Westvale Roads to be cracked seal. 100 Block of Fern Road the corner will be milled out and the pavement in that area will be replace.
- 3- Basins are being clean each day- If the Public has a basin problem on their street please call Highway Department.
- 4- The Highway Committee Chair was notified by Congressman Katko's Office regarding Helmi Drive mailboxes were approved by Unites States Post Office. Twenty Seven residents will be notified by the Township by letter when they can place a mailbox at the end of their residential property instead of going to the corner to pick up their mail.
- 5- Dwight Park ditching was perform to bring water runoff to a pond that was covered. Businesses were very pleased this was the first time done since the building of Dwight Park- Now the business properties are dry.
- 6- Solvay School Bus Garage Update - Highway Superintendent has talked with County Legislator Miles Bottrill about when the project will start for the drainage problem also waiting for possible money from Onondaga County to help pay for the project.
- 7- Paul and Carol Rolince came to the meeting to complain about foliage that was created on Terry Road and Fern Road by the County of Onondaga when the road was widen years ago as an embankment which the embankment has started to move causing a problem. The County of Onondaga will be notified of said problem.
