

HIGHWAY COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

Location: Geddes Town Hall

Date: Tuesday, March 26, 2019

Time: 6:20 PM – 7:10PM

- Update from Highway Superintendent Paul Trovato as of March 19, the Highway Department salted the roads 30 times and plowed the roads 25 times
- Update on Wiltshire Road repairs- Highway Department stated it's a drainage problem that is cause mud boil holes in the road and will start to repair the problem as soon as weather permits-Town Engineer Greg Sgromo will assist the Highway Superintendent with the design of the drainage problem.
- Fay Road project before the Highway Committee meets again with the City of Syracuse, County of Onondaga, National Grid, and OWCA, the town engineer will gather more information about the roadway problems to be done within two weeks
- Crosswalks will be added to the intersection around schools this summer
- The Community Development projects information was put together and sent in for grant money.
- A road repair list for the Westvale area was put together by the committee and handed over to the Highway Superintendent
- A list of road pavement cost estimates was reviewed by the committee and hoping for a CHIPS Grant to covered some of the costs. (Note the cost of these paving projects are more than what the CHIPS Grant would provide) Also these paving estimates were sent to Assemblyman Bill Magnarelli's office for review of possible funding – The quotes are from Suit-Kote
- Highway Superintendent Paul Trovonio gave the Committee a listed inventory of the highway equipment and the mileage of the equipment. Some of this equipment is date back to 1997.
- Highway Superintendent Paul Trovonio stated he will purchase seal crack for roads that already have been paved to preserve the road from getting any water inside of the pavement.
- Blueberry Road and Granger drainage piping has to be repaired and the Town Engineer will design how the pipe will be fix . This repair might be done this year based on the costs or money received from grants
- Highway Superintendent Paul Trovonio stated catch basins (26) are being fix – if the public sees a catch basin that is not properly working please call the highway department because it is important to keep these basins clean which prevent flooding.
- Dwight Park Roadway and drainage will be worked on as soon as the weather permits.
