1 – Survey questions are attached and have been forwarded to the Committee, Ed Weber and Chris Maroney for their input. Once the questions have been approved, a survey will be put together on Survey Monkey, placed on Facebook and the Town's website for the community's input.

2 – Once we have answers from the survey, we should organize a meeting and contact some neighborhood residents to get their opinions and input of features at Lakeland Park to be changed, added or left alone. Also, we should review the survey results.

3 – Solvay/Lakeland Little League usually uses the John Carno Recreation Center for Registration for their season in February. Since the building is closed, should we allow it if they request it? They have started online registration. It's normally on a few Saturdays, which means someone would have to work and take temperatures and make sure everyone completes the health questionnaires.

3 – Advertise for the Seasonal Park Laborer position to begin in April and end in November, at the rate of \$12.50 an hour, part time with no benefits, with a maximum of 20 hours a week

4 – Confirm organizations submitting to us a security deposit to insure that fields/buildings they utilize are cleaned and picked up during and at the end of the season. I have requested Dave Herkala, of the attorney's office to develop a waiver or contract.

5 – The "To Do" list for the parks. We will draw it up and submit it to the Highway Department, listing the most important projects to be done as soon as possible.

6 – Summer programming?? Is it safe to run playground program, summer concerts, youth sports (lacrosse, tennis)?
