

**A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTER 185 OF THE GEDDES TOWN CODE,
STREETS AND SIDEWALKS, BY ADDING A NEW §85-8.1 WITH REGARD TO
IMPROPER REMOVAL OF SNOW AND ICE**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF GEDDES AS
FOLLOWS:

Section 1:

The Town of Geddes Town Code, being Local Law No.1 of 2001, as has previously been amended, is hereby further amended by adding a new §85-8.1 Improper removal of snow and ice, to read as follows:

§185-8.1 Improper removal and disposal of snow and ice.

A. No person shall plow, shovel, sweep or pile snow, ice or other such materials in or beyond the right-of-way of any street or public highway or cause such to be done so as to interfere with the safety and convenience of public travel or such as to constitute an obstruction of the sight of persons traveling by vehicle or by foot on public streets or sidewalks or on private driveways.

B. No person shall plow, shovel or pile snow from a private or public driveway in such a manner as to deposit the same in the public roadway or on a public right-of-way or sidewalk or across the street from said driveway or onto the property of another without that person's consent.

Section 2:

Local law No. 1 of 2001, as amended, remains in full force and effect except as hereinabove amended.

Section 3:

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
