

Recreation & Youth / Senior Citizens Committee Meeting
Sept. 29, 2020 at 5:00 p.m. at Geddes Town Hall

1 – Lakeland Park Issues to be addressed:

- Trees need to be cut down and trimmed
- Mulch put down around playscape
- Topsoil & Grass seed for sinkhole
- Finish paving area dugout in parking lot
- Pavilion roofs need repair
- Paint picnic tables and pavilions
- Courts pressure washed and cracks filled in
- Cameras – if parks get wireless
- Dumpster – illegal dumping (cameras will help)

2 – Ideas about how to beautify Lakeland Park:

- Remove tennis courts?
- Move playscape, swings and slide to that location?
 - Playscape is too small to be the only thing in the area
- Paint and repair pavilions and stairs to lower field
- Remove both sets of stairs to lower field and replace with ramps
- Basketball courts enhanced (pressured washed, cracks filled and weeds removed)
- Move batting cage to lower field/parking lot to open up the area
- Remove weeds from backstops and fence areas by fields
- Remove dead trees and plant new ones in more suitable areas
- Remove old Lion's Club monument at Beachview gate entrance
- Community Development grant (if approved) to place pervious paving around the pavilions; improve gated area by Beachview to be pedestrian and bicycle friendly (including ADA); and bring handicap parking up to current standards.

3 – Girl Scouts are requesting to resume their meeting starting in October

- They meet on Tuesday evenings, upstairs, so we already have someone scheduled to work. They have guidelines and protocol from the GSA. They can only have 8 girls and 2 leaders meet at a time.
- If we allow them usage, they will have specific requirements to follow.

4 – Approval to have Jonathan Waite remove dead trees from Lakeland Park and remove the Christmas lights from tree at Parsons Dr. and replaced after they have been checked (funds in budget)

5 – John Carno Building Usage Data and Re-opening to Public
