Town of Geddes Pavilion Reservations

(Memorial Day weekend to Columbus Day Weekend)

The Town of Geddes Department of Parks and Recreation began accepting reservations for the use of the pavilions on **Tuesday**, **January 3**, **2023**.

Lakeland Park is located on Alhan Parkway and the reservation entitles you to the use of the large pavilion, restrooms, and electricity. Facilities at Lakeland Park include tennis courts, basketball courts, field areas and playground equipment. Lindbergh Lawns Park is located on Bennett Ave. in the Lindbergh Lawns area and include a small pavilion, bathrooms, half court basketball area and playground equipment.

To reserve either park pavilion, the following fees apply:

Geddes residents: \$75.00 Rental fee and a \$100.00 security deposit will be required.

Non-residents: \$100.00 Rental fee and a \$100.00 security deposit will be required.

Security deposits will be returned within 10 business days of the rental date, barring any damage to the Pavilion, bathrooms or park grounds.

Reservations must be made at least two (2) weeks in advance. Cancellations must be made at least two (2) weeks in advance by notifying the Department of Parks and Recreation at 487-8238 and a refund will be issued. After two (2) weeks prior, a refund will not be issued. In the case of rain, we do not reschedule permit dates.

Town of Geddes Park Regulations & Policies

In order to **help keep our parks clean, safe and usable by all**, Local Law 8 of the year 2001, entitled "Park Regulations" was enacted to govern park use in the Town of Geddes. The law in its entirety can found in the Town of Geddes Code Book – Chapter 143. Some of the regulations adopted are listed below:

Park Hours: The Town Of Geddes policy towards the hours of use of it's parks shall be as follows:

A. - Parks shall be open for use by the public from <u>8:00 am until 15 minutes prior</u> to <u>Sunset daily</u>. These hours of operation apply to use by the public in general as well as groups who rent orreserve fields within the parks.

B. - No park or field shall be used after sunset and the use of mobile or temporary lighting (e.g. vehicle headlights or roof lights, electric lights, battery operated lights) to artificially light a field afterSunset is expressly prohibited.

Pavilion Use: Memorial Day Weekend to Columbus Day Weekend only.

Facilities and areas in the park shall be used only for the purposes designated or implicit in their character.

No person shall carry into and/or have possession of any **glass** beverage containers.

It shall be unlawful to bring or cause to be brought any animal into any park, recreation or playground area, except for trained guide dogs for the blind which are expressly exempt from all provisions of the chapter.

Fires may not be built or allowed anywhere in park or playground areas except in stoves, fireplaces, or designated areas provided for that purpose.

Licensed motor vehicles shall be permitted only on designated roadways, and vehicles shall be parked in areas of places so provided and designated. Motor scooters, motorcycles, minibikes, go-carts, and snowmobiles shall not be permitted.

Commit any act which is defined as criminal conduct under the New York State Penal Law.

Any conduct which constitutes a violation of this chapter will be a violation, punishable by up to fifteen (15) days in jail and/or a fine of up to \$250.00. Each such violation shall constitute a separate violation punishable under this section.

HELP KEEP OUR PARKS CLEAN AND SAFE, if you see anyone misusing the park - please let us know. To report any problems, etc. call the Geddes Police or the Geddes Recreation Department.

**Also the Town supports the county's initiative in public parks by adopting a "no smoking" policy in town parks. The enforcement of this policy is through voluntary compliance.

Holiday Schedule - 2023 for Garbage and Recycling Pick ups

ABSOLUTELY NO MATTRESSES BOXSPRINGS WILL BE PICKED UP BY THE GEDDES HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT.

Curbside pickup of YARD WASTE, GARBAGE, **CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS & OTHER REFUSE** is for the benefit of Geddes residents. There should be no drop-offs from non-residents to residences located in the Town of Geddes.

**Services performed by the Town of Geddes Highway Dept. are for residents doing the work themselves at their homes.

**Any contractor doing remodeling or repairs on a Town residence is responsible for the disposal of any debris from the remodeling/repairs.

1. BRUSH and YARD WASTE PICK-UP **SCHEDULE**

Monday - Lakeland area (Including Linbergh Lawns)

Thursday - W.Genesee St., Wilshire Rd., Wynthrop Rd., Hatherleigh Rd., Chaumont Dr., Century Dr., Southview Rd., N.Terry Rd., Timberwolf Circle, Copliegh Dr., Kenyon Dr., Westlind Rd., Westfall Dr., Stanley Dr., Clearview Dr., Horseshoe Dr., Duchess La., Watchtower La., Blackstone Wy., W. Granger Rd. from S. Terry Rd to town line, Limestone La., Treeland Circle, Crabapple La., Blueberry La., Pumpkin La., Spructree La., Kimberly Dr.

Fridays - Westvale area (Westholm Blvd. section to Avery Ave., City Line) - (subject to change due to pick up volume and weather)

Grass Clippings will be picked up during regular yard waste days from April 1st through December 1st as is the current schedule. All grass clippings MUST BE in PA-PER BAGS, CARDBOARD BOXES or a container NOT TO EXCEED 50 lbs. ABSOLUTELY NO PLAS-**TIC BAGS!** (Mulching is a better alternative)

All yard waste, other than tree branches, must be in paper bags, cardboard boxes, trash cans. (NO PLAS-TIC BAGS) - there is a 50 lb limit for barrels and **bags**

Loose raked leaves in wind rows along your front yard (do not put in roadway) will only be picked up from October 1st through Dec. 1st. All other times of the year, rakings must be in paper bags, cardboard boxes,or trash cans. (NO BLUE BINS).

2. BULK ITEM PICK-UP SCHEDULE

Picked up day after garbage and recycling, except Lakeland and Lindbergh Lawns which will be picked

Bulk items include: Furniture (NOT including mattresses/boxsprings), clothing, large plastic toys, etc. ** No full house clean outs

3. **CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS**

Picked up day after garbage and recycling, except Lakeland and Lindbergh Lawns which will be picked up on Monday.

No more that 3 cubic yards at one time (equal to a pickup truck full), year round with weather permitting.

Construction debris is: toilets, sinks, bathtubs, shower doors, cabinets, countertops, sheet rock, wood, doors (wood & metal), windows, siding, paneling, insulation, roofing, plywood and electrical.

No fluorescent fixtures.

4. WHITE GOODS PICK-UP -

Picked up same day as brush and yard waste.

White good items are – Stoves, dishwashers, clothes dryers, washing machines, hot watertanks, small amounts of scrap metal, etc.

5. CONCRETE, STONES, DIRT, ETC.

A wheelbarrow full (approx. 4 cu. ft.) will be picked up once a month from April 1st through November 1st. Residents must call Highway Garage Department and be placed on list (488-7705)

The following items WILL NOT BE PICKED UP BY OUR DEPT.

Tires, gas tanks, l.p. tanks, car parts, refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, microwaves, t.v.'s computer monitors, mattresses and box

The Highway Department does not accept electronics. Please visit **ocrra.org** for recycling options.

Please note: Only wind damage and Christmas Trees will be picked up curbside from December 1st to April 1^{st} .

Please do not leave any construction debris, bulk items or yard waste in front of the salt barn or in the parking lots at any time.

GARBAGE

From the Code Enforcement / Fire Marshall's Office:

David Balcer, Code Enforcement Officer/Fire Marshall

Check with our office or the Town website on what projects require a Building Permit. Replacing existing fences, sheds, decks/porches, etc. all require Building Permits. Zoning Code & Building Codes change over the years and the new codes must be met. Projects that get overlooked as requiring a Building Permit is basement remodeling and turning garages to habitable spaces. Basements and garages are designed as utility/storage spaces. Turning them into habitable spaces requires a Building Permit for code compliance to be met. The main concern is the secondary means of egress out of the basement must be met. When N.Y.S. adopted the current 2020 Residential Building Code, all new houses were required to have this secondary means already installed to make the conversion easier, but still requiring a Building Permit when done.

Here are some reminders for the season: We will address all written complaints submitted to our office filled out with your name, address & phone number. Complaints are kept confidential and the forms are available on our website or in our office. Basketball hoops should not be set up and left in the road right-ofway, it is very dangerous to have them there. Recreational fire pits are allowed, but all regulations need to be complied with, including most importantly that it is cleaned seasoned wood that is burned. The same you would use in an indoor

Street Lighting Project Completed in Westvale

New York Power Authority (NYPA) Crews have finally completed the conversion of streetlights to LED in the Westvale area. Many Westvale residents have complemented the upgrade in lighting in their neighborhoods. Westvale residents should contact the Town Highway Garage at 315-488-7705 to report an outage. Residents in Solvay and Lakeland will continue to contact Solvay Electric Department for outages.

Sewer Infrastructure

Commissioner Shannon Harty and other representatives from the Onondaga County Department of Water Environment Protection (WEP) held an informational town hall meeting on April 19th, specifically addressing the sewer concerns of residents of Bronson Road. Bronson Road has been experiencing a high volume of service calls due to sewer backups and storm water overflow. Multiple studies on Bronson have been done in the past. In 2011, WEP partnered with the Town of Geddes to install backwater valves on individual laterals to protect homes that were experiencing frequent basement backups. But the backwater valves only treat the symptom, not the problem. Field inspections and localized closed circuit television (CCTV) inspections have been done to find sources of infiltration into the sewer system. Potential sources include; sump pump, footer drains, City of Syracuse water main breaks as well as cracks in the sewer

What's Next? Field investigations will continue to try and identify the cause of the problem on Bronson Road and the surrounding area.

Investigations include:

- Flow monitoring
- Increased cleaning to prevent clogs
- More manhole inspections

- Smoke testing
- More CCTV inspections
- Groundwater monitoring

Once WEP knows the root cause they are then able to find a long-term solution. During this investigation period, homeowners can help by doing the following:

- If you have a floor drain in your basement, plug it.
- Consider eliminating our basement sewer connection if you don't need it.
- If you have a sump pump, foundation drain, and/or roof drain, check to see if connects to your sanitary sewer lateral. If it does, disconnect it and let it drain to a ditch outside.
- Fats, oils, grease, wipes and other hygiene products should be thrown away in the trash can, not flushed down the drain. These items can cause "fatbergs" that clogs pipes.

Tree Committee

At a recent meeting of the Geddes Tree Committee, the group drafted a proposed Geddes Tree Ordinance which was presented at the Administrative Committee and distributed to legal counsel, members of the zoning, planning and Town Boards for their review and feedback. This ordinance is needed in order for Geddes to be certified by the Arbor Day Foundation as "Tree City USA" status. By earning Tree City USA status, the Town will be eligible for additional sources of public and private grant funding. The Town will provide updates to the residents on the status of this issue.

EXEMPTIONS

Please be advised, the Assessor's office has completed the processing of all applications for exemptions, including but not limited to, the Enhanced STAR, Senior Citizens with Limited Income, Persons with Disabilities and Limited Income, Veterans, Volunteer Firefighters and Volunteer Ambulance Workers, Business and Clergy Members.

We would like to inform you, if you did not submit your renewal exemption form or if your income was over the allowed amount, we were not able to roll over any exemptions this year like we were able to do the previous two years due to Covid.

The Town of Geddes Assessor's Office, as a courtesy, will mail out all renewal applications for exemptions in September 2023. When applying for the Enhanced Star exemption, please provide a copy of your Federal Income Tax return for 2022 with the completed application. When applying for the Senior Citizen with Limited Income exemption please provide a copy of your 2022 Federal Income Tax (or any end of year statements) with the completed application and the 2022 end of the year Social Security Benefit Statement. Any owner, who presently receives the Basic Star, turning 65 by December 2024, may be eligible for the Enhanced Star. All applications for exemptions must be filed by our annual taxable status date, MARCH 1st.

PLEASE MAKE SURE ALL APPLICATIONS ARE SIGNED AND DATED

There have been some changes to the STAR Exemption Program. If you are a new owner or do not already have a STAR Exemption on your primary residence, you may qualify for a STAR Relief Check. To apply, you will need to

contact New York State Department of Taxation and Finance at (518) 457-2036 OR register online at WWW.TAX.NY.GOV/STAR and click on "Register for Star" and follow the instructions.

Also, if you have missed the March 1st deadline for filing for the Enhanced STAR program, you can file a good cause RP-425-GC with New York State or contact them directly at the number above.

To find out more information and/or eligibility requirements for any exemptions or if you would like to confirm we have received your exemption paperwork, please call our office at (315) 468-3600, Extension 4.

Just a reminder, there may be people in your area gathering information for the data collection project regarding the grant that we received from New York State.
